5 **Gastritis** and Gastropathy Stephanie L. Hansel, MD, MS Inflammation of the stomach can manifest itself as **gaстритис** or gastropathy. **Gastritis** is a histologic diagnosis referring to inflammatory processes of the stomach. **Gastritis** may or may not have identifiable endoscopic findings or clinical symptoms. In comparison, gastropathy refers to epithelial damage with little or no inflammation. There are several classifications of **gaстритис** and gastropathy. Most of them distinguish between acute and chronic disease and the predominant inflammatory infiltrate
